## WHAT'S YOUR STATUS?

Did you know that your nonprofit or community group must file a 990 with the IRS? Do you know if you still have a valid corporation under Maryland law? The IRS predicts that half a million nonprofits will lose their tax exemption status in 2010 due to stricter enforcement of existing rules. ***Come learn how to prevent your organization from losing its tax exemption!***

The Community Law Center in partnership with PNC Bank and the Maryland Department of Housing & Community Development's Catalyst Training Academy is offering four workshops designed for board members, executive directors and management of Maryland nonprofit organizations, ranging from small, volunteer-run community organizations to larger non-stock corporations. Topics will include discussions of bylaws, annual state and federal filing requirements, revival of corporations, registration for solicitations, insurance needs, and more. PNC Bank's nonprofit bankers will also present basic financial literacy for nonprofits.
